**Dear Parents/Carers** 

Looking ahead to the second half of the summer term, I would like to remind you of our expectations for all our students.

## **KCSS Cards**

'KCSS' cards are issued to students to encourage them to be [K] *kind*, [C] *courteous*, [S] *smart* and [S] *successful*. Students are rewarded by being given a card by any member of staff who sees them being kind, courteous, smart or successful.

We expect all students to be respectful and considerate to all members of the school community at all times.

## Punctuality

Being punctual is an important life skill that we value at Southchurch High School. It is vital that our students arrive at school on time and are well prepared for the school day. We encourage all students to arrive early, there is a Breakfast Club for those who do, with free tea, toast and cereal available.

A late gate system is in operation to improve punctuality. When students arrive on site after 8.30 am they are late. Those students will be issued with a 30-minute detention at break time. If students arrive after 9.00 am, they will receive a one hour detention after school that day.

## Uniform

Being in uniform generates a sense of belonging, pride, and loyalty towards the school. Student uniform is checked at the start of the school day and where students are found to be in the incorrect uniform, they will be provided with the correct items from the school's stock and expected to wear them. A copy of the uniform code is attached for reference.

Infringement cards will be signed whenever a student is found to be in the incorrect uniform. Six signatures will lead to a detention.

## SLT Detention

When detentions are set, we expect our students to take responsibility and attend these. If any student fails to attend a scheduled detention this may result in them being placed in an SLT detention. These detentions will take place on Mondays from 3:05 to 5:00pm. All detentions set will be communicated via text message. If a student fails to attend an SLT detention, this will result in a day of isolation.
